- 1) What are some of your favorite things about this time of year (or do you miss summer)?
- 2) How have you and your family been dealing with this new school year and new season of life? What challenges have you faced and what unexpected blessings have you encountered?
- 3) Read Rev 10:4-7; 2 Pet 3:2-3, 8-10. Why is God's timing for the world's end perfect? What is God trying to accomplish by delaying its end until the right time?
- 4) Read Rev 10:8-11. Why was God's Word sweet and bitter for John? What are some of the truths you find hard to swallow in God's Word? What keeps you from feeding on the Word and digesting it?
- 5) Read Rev 11:3-10. Why does the world rejoice at the death of the 2 witnesses? Do you see that same spirit today? Why or why not?
- 6) Read Rev 11:11-14. How does God promise to vindicate those who faithfully serve Him even unto death? How should that give us confidence and hope? See John 11:25-26; 1 Cor 15:51-55.
- 7) What role is God calling you to take in these challenging times we're living in? What makes you fearful about serving Him and how can you be encouraged?
