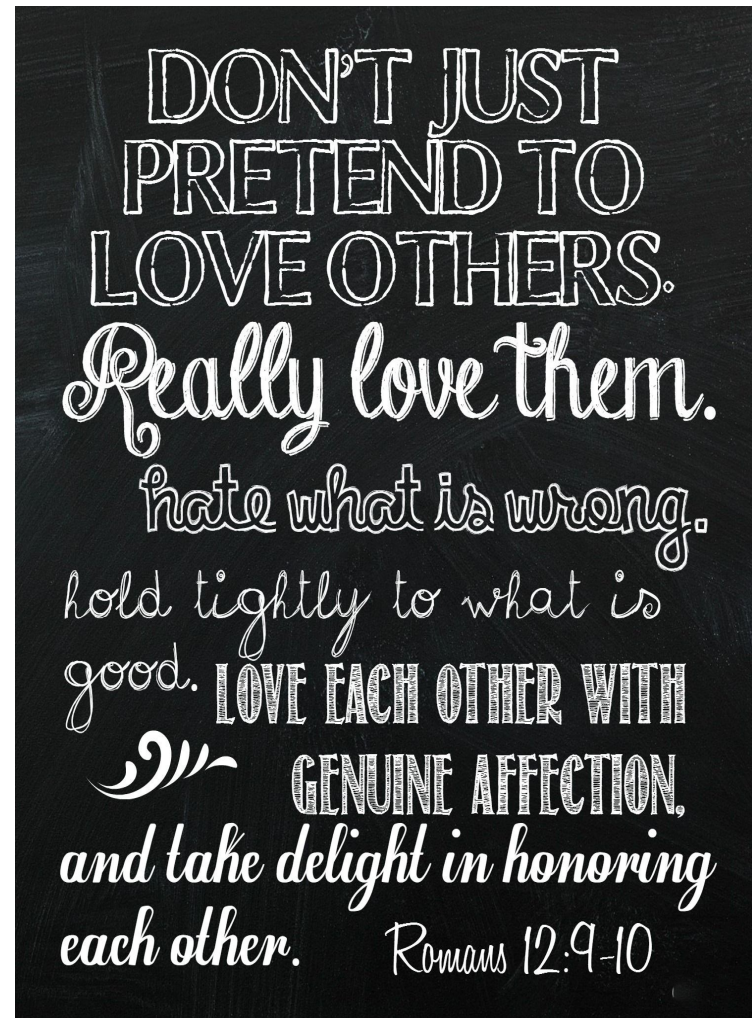

## Discussion / Devotional Questions Church (counter) Culture Week 4 – **A Culture of Honor**

### Read Romans 12:10

1. What do you think Paul means by "brotherly affection"? How would you describe or explain brotherly affection to someone?
2. What attitudes or ways of thinking can prevent an atmosphere of brotherly affection in the church?
3. Think of a situation where someone was intentionally honored. How were they treated? What does it mean to be the Guest of Honor? How is that person treated?

### Read Genesis 1:27

4. How should the fact that people are created in the image of God affect how we treat them?

### Read Romans 12:16

5. Why is it such a tall order to be "like minded"? What makes living in harmony a tough thing to accomplish?

### Read Romans 12:16-18

6. Verse 18 tells us to strive to "live peaceably with all". Verses 16 and 17 give us a short list of things to work on in order to achieve that end. Put that list of things from verses 16 and 17 into your own words.
