Discussion / Devotional Questions The Fruitful Life: Gentleness

- Read Titus 3:2. How does this verse compare to what we see on social media and cable news these days? What do you see in this verse that you might need to work on?
- 2. Read Philippians 4:5. In several places in the Scripture we are told to keep certain virtuous behaviors (like generous giving or extended prayer times) secret, yet Paul tell us we should put the virtue of gentleness on full display for all to see. Why do you think that is?
- 3. Read Galatians 6:1. This verse gives us a prescription for what to do when someone in the church is caught in significant sin. What does confronting sin "in a spirit of gentleness" look like in real life?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 3:15. Why do you think it's important to be gentle and respectful when sharing our faith?
- 5. Read James 3:13. How do good works, meekness/gentleness, and wisdom fit together?
- 6. Read Matthew 11:28-29. Jesus said that people who came to Him would find rest, and find it right down to the level of the soul. How can we be more like Jesus in this way? What are some things we do that can get in the way of others finding rest in our presence?
