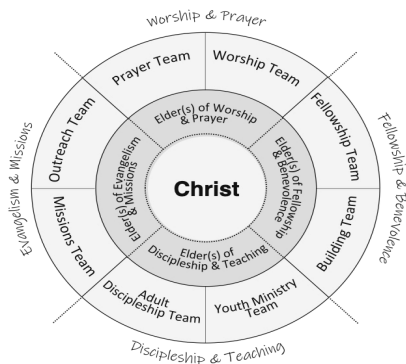

## Discussion / Devotional Questions

### 2 Peter 2

#### "A Self-Destructive Lifestyle"

1. How do the deceptive philosophies of our world infiltrate the church today?
2. Peter tells us that there are eight characteristics that false teachers display: underhandedness, lust, greed, rebellion, arrogance, brazenness, meaninglessness and bondage. How have you seen false teachers display these negative behaviors?
3. Peter's words about condemnation and judgement sound harsh to modern ears. Why is God perfectly just when He judges false teachers and those who rebel against Him?
4. What hope do those who trust in the Lord have to overcome the destructive philosophies of this world? (See verses 6 to 9)
5. Why is it wrong for Christians to think that they can bind demons or tell them what to do? (See verses 10 to 12)
6. How is Balaam from the Old Testament a perfect example of false teachers today? (See verses 14 to 16 and Numbers 22-31)
7. What does Peter mean when he says, "they are worse off at the end than they were at the beginning" (verse 20), and "it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness" (verse 21)?
8. How can you make sure you only listen to those who teach the truth of God's Word?
