Genesis 12:1-9 Discussion Questions

- 1. What makes moving to a new location so stressful?
- 2. Why must our congregation be willing to do new and daring things for God?
- 3. In Joshua 24:2 we are told that Abram's father, Terah, worshipped idols. Terah also stalled the family from going into the Promised Land (Genesis 11:27-32). How do false gods hold us back from doing God's will today?
